Project Background

Think Energy assisted Toyota in the purchase of two rooftop photovoltaic systems.

- A 2.3 megawatt system at Toyota's Parts and Distribution Center in Ontario, California. This system will be installed in the spring of 2008.
- A 536 kilowatt system, installed in 2004, at Toyota's U.S. headquarters in Torrance, California. This facility is one of the world's largest Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) projects.
